President Linda Falconer called the Mill Village Borough Council meeting for April 6, 2022 to order at 6:30 p.m.

Edward Falconer motioned to accept the agenda, Steve Yovich seconded, all in favor, motion carried.

Shannon Nye motioned to pass the Consent Agenda including the Minutes from the Regular meeting – March 2, 2022 and the Treasurer's Report for March 31, 2022. Steve Yovich seconded motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Shawn McLaughlin motioned to donate the following to the Waterford Library: \$1,000.00 from the Mill Village General Fund and \$1,000.00 from the ARPA fund. Shannon Nye seconded. All voted yes.

Borough Maintenance: Edward Falconer reported: He is still trying to contact Ford about the problems with the new truck. He will be getting a quote to have pine trees on the Mill Village Community Park property removed. Tabled. He will be cleaning drains and purchasing Cold Patch for potholes on Old Meadville Road and South Main Street. Shawn McLaughlin and Ed Falconer will look at drainage pipe in McLaughlin Field.

Drew Watkins stated that a residence on Woods Road in Mill Village Borough is playing loud music. Mayor Joe Sam will be asked to speak with them and ask that they keep the noise down.

The Penelec Rep was contacted to discuss additional questions. Tabled until more information can be acquired.

New Business:

Attorney Buzz Andrezeski, MVVFC reps Dave Stearns and Rhonda Eggleston were present to discuss A Billing Ordinance for the Mill Village Volunteer Fire Company. Attorney Andrezeski presented a proposed ordinance. The proposed ordinance will be sent to Solicitor Tim Sennett for review and he will be asked to contact Attorney Andrezeski to discuss the Ordinance. The MVVFC will contact LeBoeuf Township and Rockdale Township, in regards to the billing ordinance, the other municipalities may also need to pass a similar ordinance for billing. All three left at 7:13 p.m.

The Erie County Parks, Trails & Recreation Feasibility Assessment was sent in. Councilman Steve Yovich is researching grants for Park improvements and sidewalks within Mill Village Borough. Discussion was held on a sidewalk to the new Dollar General Store.

Edward Falconer made a motion to pay payroll and monthly bills for March 31, 2022 seconded by Steve Yovich. All voted yes.

Construction of the New Dollar General has been started. The Escrow Account has been opened, signature cards were signed by the President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer.
