

Mill Village Borough Regular Meeting
Wednesday – August 6, 2025

Secretary/Treasurer Catherine Wise called to order The Regular Meeting of the Mill Village Borough Council at 6:30 p.m. Mark Costello nominated Steve Yovich as President Pro-Tem, Sean Falconer seconded. All voted yes.

Council members in attendance: Dave Alexander, Steve Yovich, Mark Costello and Sean Falconer. Also in attendance: Secretary /Treasurer Catherine Wise

Mark Costello motioned to accept the Proposed Agenda. Sean Falconer seconded. All voted yes.

Sean Falconer motioned to approve the Minutes from the July 2, 2025, Regular meeting and the July 31, 2025, Treasurer's Report. Dave Alexander seconded. All voted yes.

Secretary Catherine Wise sent a letter to Blum's on South Main Street and they still have not mowed the grass. Councilman Mark Costello volunteered to speak with them. A resident on South Main Street asked about Brush and Branch disposal. They will be informed that they can be taken to the Transfer Station on Woods Road but they should call Maintenance man Tim Pie first.

Maintenance Man Tim Pie: Submitted his maintenance report – Attached. Tim suggested looking at the basin on South Main Street and the Ditch on South Depot Street.

Mark Costello asked about Council members as employees. Can they be paid for part-time work? Tabled

The Solar Signs were sent to Stalker/Applied Concepts Inc. for repairs, and the Insurance Company will pay for all repair costs after the \$500.00 deposit.

Council members discussed drilling a well and capping the septic at the Community Park. Mark Costello motioned to authorize \$600.00 to have Travis Blum dig up the area by the assumed septic location and have it filled in. Sean Falconer seconded. All voted yes.

Mark Costello motioned to hire Travis Blum to grade the dirt in front of and beside the Municipal Building and place a few loads of topsoil from the New Church pile for a cost of \$1,250.00. Dave Alexander seconded. All voted yes.

In regard to the painting of lines in the parking lot, they should make sure they meet all state rules. Council members discussed paying for the paint. Tabled.

Steve Yovich motioned to pay payroll and monthly bills for July 31, 2025, seconded by Dave Alexander. All voted yes.
