

Mill Village Borough Regular Meeting
Wednesday – April 3, 2024

Vice President Shawn McLaughlin, called to order The Regular Meeting of the Mill Village Borough Council to order at 6:30 p.m.

Council members in attendance: Edward Falconer, David Alexander, Mark Costello, Steve Yovich and Sean Falconer Also in attendance: Mayor Joe Sam and Secretary/Treasurer Catherine Wise. Resident Paul Peters and Land Bank Reps: Christie Mahaney & Krista Arnold

Edward Falconer motioned to accept the Proposed Agenda. Steve Yovich seconded. All voted yes.

Steve Yovich motioned to approve the Minutes from the February 7, 2024 and the February 29, 2024 Treasurer's Report. Shawn McLaughlin seconded. All voted yes.

The Secretary/Treasurer reported that 3 military banners have been ordered. Waiting for more orders. Insurance will be renewed soon. A letter was sent concerning the trees on the New Park Property.

Road Foreman Edward Falconer reported that there has been no snowplowing. The speed sign on the East side of time

Paul Peters is still complaining about the light on the back of the Municipal Building, shining on his property. He feels that it should only be on when people are in the building. A timer was installed to run the light between 6:00 and 10:00 p.m. George Cornwell is looking into installing a shield on the light.

Shawn McLaughlin motioned to remove the light. Steve Yovich seconded the motion. The following voted yes: Shawn McLaughlin and Steve Yovich. The following voted no: Edward Falconer, Mark Costello, David alexander, and Sean Falconer. Motion died.

Steve Yovich informed Council members that the pile of Soil on the New Church property is available for free to fill in areas by the roadway, on North Main Street, for future sidewalk construction. Council members discussed asking PennDOT if the material would be acceptable for base material. Edward Falconer and Mark Costello will contact PennDOT to ask for a representative to attend one of the Mill Village Borough Council meetings in the near future to answer questions about the replacement of the bridge on north main street and installation of sidewalks from East Center Street to Depot Street on the West side of North Main Street.

The Spring Newsletter was reviewed and discussed.
The Co-Op Fence was tabled until a future meeting.

Mark Costello motioned to bid & place tar & chip on Gillette Street and Old Meadville Road in 2024. Sean Falconer seconded. All voted yes. It has been suggested to perform crack sealing, patching and berm work on the roadways before placing the Tar & Chip. An Intergovernmental agreement will be signed with LeBoeuf Township.

Edward Falconer motioned to pay payroll and monthly bills for February 29, 2024, seconded by Mark Costello. All voted yes.

General Comments from Council President: Linda requested that all the council members meet with Ed Falconer to learn how to hook up the generator to the traffic light.

Councilman E. Falconer – the door on the Small Building can be raised to accommodate the tractor for a cost of \$1,300.00. The Light on the Tractor may need a hinge installed on the light so that it can be lowered to fit in the Small Building. Tabled.

Councilman McLaughlin– Asked about Horse ownership within Mill Village Borough. Horses are permitted in Rural Residential (R-1) zones.

Councilman Alexander– Asked about Gaming Revenue, which was decided years ago, only Summit Township and municipalities which touch Summit Township are eligible for yearly gaming revenue funds. There are grants available to Municipalities for certain projects through the Gaming Commission.
