

Mill Village Borough Regular Meeting  
Wednesday – November 5, 2025

President Linda Falconer called to order The Regular Meeting of the Mill Village Borough Council at 6:30 p.m.

Council members in attendance: Edward Falconer, Shawn McLaughlin, Dave Alexander, Steve Yovich, Mark Costello and Sean Falconer. Also in attendance: Secretary /Treasurer Catherine Wise. Residents Dale Carnahan and Josh Mikesell.

Edward Falconer motioned to accept the Proposed Agenda. Dave Alexander seconded. All voted yes.

Mark Cosello motioned to approve the Minutes from October 1, 2025, Regular meeting and October 31, 2025, Treasurer's Report. Shawn McLaughlin seconded. All voted yes.

Secretary Catherine Wise presented an email concerning a reduction of speed by the new park – a citizen would like a speed sign posted. Bruce Wise stated that he is still interested in Plowing for the Mill Village Borough when he is able. Steve Yovich motioned to allow President Linda Falconer to sign the Building Permit for the Mill Village Community Park, Dave Alexander seconded. All voted yes.

The location of the well and septic tank at the park were tabled again.
