

Mill Village Borough Regular Meeting  
Wednesday – September 11, 2024

President Linda Falconer, called to order The Regular Meeting of the Mill Village Borough Council to order at 6:30 p.m.

Council members in attendance: Shawn McLaughlin, David Alexander, Sean Falconer, Mark Costello and Steve Yovich. Also in attendance: Mayor Joe Sam, Secretary/Treasurer Catherine Wise and Tim Pietrasewicz..

Mark Costello motioned to accept the Proposed Agenda. Sean Falconer seconded. All voted yes.

Shawn McLaughlin motioned to approve the Minutes from the August 7, 2024, Regular meeting and the August 31, 2024, Treasurer's Report. Dave Alexander seconded. All voted yes.

Discussion was held on the National Fuel invoice. The Insurance company has agreed to pay half, and Selective Insurance tried to have the contractor's insurance company pay half, but Council members accept all liability and would like the Selective insurance company to pay the other half.

Mark Costello visited Patrick and Mallory Waldron and Marc Gray. Mr. Gray has placed signs in his yard which are not family friendly. The Health Department was called in regard to the Mallory's swimming pool. They will be winterizing the pool soon. The State Police have been called to the properties. There has been yelling between the two neighbors. This is a civil case and the Residents were advised to document everything that happens.
