RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 1

A RESOLUTION OF MILL VILLAGE BOROUGH, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL TAX COLLECTION LAW TO WAIVE FEES OR PENALTIES ASSOCIATED WITH LATE FILING OF REAL PROPERTY TAXES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Councilmen and Councilwomen of Mill Village Borough (the "Borough") have the authority to levy and impose taxes on the assessed value of real property located within the Borough boundaries and have levied said tax in 2021; and


WHEREAS, the Local Tax Collection Law, at 72 P.S. Section 5511.10, permits the Borough to provide relief to taxpayers for 2021 real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough, its citizens and its taxpayers to provide real property tax relief for fiscal year 2021 due to financial difficulties caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Councilmen & Councilwomen of Mill Village Borough hereby waives any fees or penalties associated with the late payment of tax imposed on the assessed value of real estate located within the Borough, provided that the tax is paid in its entirety by December 31, 2021.


