

## **ORDINANCE NO. 8**

An ordinance Relating to the Establishment Use and Prohibition of Sanitary Land Fills..

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of Mill Village, County of Erie and State of Pennsylvania, as follows:

### **SECTION I**

That a Sanitary Landfill is hereby established on certain land owned by the Borough of Mill Village, Pennsylvania, located off Woods Road, in the southwest corner of the Borough.

### **SECTION II**

That the said Sanitary Landfill may be used only by those persons who own land in the Borough.

### **SECTION III**

That the Residents of the Borough shall be allowed to use the Sanitary Landfill to dispose of such junk, garbage, and other refuse that is by nature properly disposed in a Sanitary Land Fill.

### **SECTION IV**

That the said Residents shall be entitled to the use of the Sanitary Land Fill on any day during daylight hours, provided, however, they shall dispose of said junk, garbage and other refuse within the Sanitary Landfill in the place and Manner directed by the proper Borough Authorities.

### **SECTION V**

That the Borough, through the Agency of its proper Authorities shall direct all disposal made within the Sanitary Land Fill and provide for the covering of all the said junk, garbage and other refuse placed upon the premises.

### **SECTION VI**

That nothing shall be disposed of left upon the premises of the Sanitary Land Fill by person or persons who are not Residents of the Borough of Mill Village.

### **SECTION VII**

That no other Dump, Sanitary Land Fills or other places used for disposal purposes shall be opened or operated within the confines of Mill Village, Pennsylvania.

### **SECTION VIII**

That any person or persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding before the Mayor or any Justice of the Peace, be subject to a fine not exceeding Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense and , in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

### **SECTION IX**

That Should any part of this Ordinance be held invalid by a Court of Competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable and shall continue to be in force and effect.

### **SECTION X**

**ORDINANCE NO. 8**

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances Conflicting with the provisions or this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this Ordinance.
