

## RESOLUTION 2 OF 1972

A Resolution of the Borough of Mill Village Borough, in Erie County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, The General Assembly of Pennsylvania has passed the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act NO. 537, and it was signed into law by the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Act 537 requires that each municipality in the Commonwealth shall submit to the Department of Health, an officially adopted plan for sewage system serving areas within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners delegated the responsibility of preparing the sewage plans for each municipality to the Erie County Planning Commission, these plans have duly been presented to the Borough of Mill Village in Erie County for its review

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved that:

The plan prepared for Erie County including Mill Village Borough has been reviewed by the elected officials of Mill Village Borough and is hereby adopted as the official Sewage Plan of Mill Village Borough with the option of a feasibility study before installation.
